

# The three styles of gold mineralisation identified and being explored for:

#### Intrusion Related Gold:

• Analogous to the **Wallaby**, **Jupiter, Cameron Well** deposits and associated with **Mafic Group** and **Syenite Group** intrusions.

#### • Orogenic Lode Gold:

• Deep tapping structures and second / third order pathways.


#### Volcanogenic Massive Sulphides:





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
# **Consolidated Tenement Package**



- 14 Mile Well is a ~ 930km<sup>2</sup> tenement package consisting of **186** individual **tenements** and 33 individual applications.
- Many tenements obtained from Local Prospectors
- Located on the west side of Lake Carey
- 80% of the tenement package has never seen any systematic geological studies.
- 5,000 historical holes drilled
  - ~ 30m avg depth






- Divided into 6 prospect areas




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# Everleigh Well High-Grade Vein

- 200m long quartz reef vein discovered, returning high-grade gold rock chip results.
- Gold in specimen stone has been found very close to source.
- Gold nuggets discovered across the Everleigh target area.
- Fieldwork and rock chip sampling of outcrop continues.

## Christmas Gift High-Grade Vein



- Gold found in outcropping quartz vein.
- Within a cluster of gold prospectivity indicators that include gold nuggets, historic workings, significant gold drill assays and significant gold rock chip assays.
- Fieldwork and rock chip sampling continues to define extensions of the vein along strike.




Observing geometry of the UG vein visible in the historic workings and sampling in-situ mineralisation.



### **Castlemaine Fault DD Hole**




- Hole FMDD0032 tested through the north trending Castlemaine Fault.
- The Northern Reflector structure was intersected at ~475m down hole.
- The hole intersected numerous gold intervals along it's ~900m length.
- **Gold intervals** are concentrated in the footwall of the Northern reflector structure.





# Everleigh Seismic Survey to 1,500m Depth



- Completed an **Integrated Geophysical Campaign** at Everleigh.
- Acquisition of new DGPR, Gravity, DEM and 2D-Seismic (31.5 line kms).
- Geophysics used to generate a **3D structural model** to guide ongoing exploration.
- Seismic interpretation identified a number of structures, most notably the Northern Reflector and the Southern Reflector.
- The Northern Reflector structure was intersected in FMDD0032 at ~475m down hole.
- The hole intersected numerous gold intervals along it's ~900m length.
- Gold intervals are concentrated in the footwall of the Northern Reflector structure.






# Goose Well Syenite




- The target area is centred on a syenite intrusion
- Central intrusion is surrounded by a magnetic reaction halo
- Numerous anomalous Au, Ag and Te bearing rock chips.
- Gold nuggets recovered from surface across the target area.






## Hage's Bore Syenite



- The gold anomaly is centred on a syenite related intrusion
- View of the central intrusion at Hage's Bore surrounded by a magnetic amphibolite halo




 Gossanous quartz vein breccia is located to the north of the central intrusion






# North 1 Target - Recon 1 Positive Diamond Drill Core






# **Claypan Target Area**




- Drilled beneath geophysical and geochemical anomalies
- All DD holes intersected significant alteration.
- Syenite intrusion identified in drill core.
- Alteration is dominated by carbonate, white mica, sulphides and chloritoid.
- The alteration assemblage is suggestive of an early, pre-metamorphic, sea floor alteration system. (VMS style mineralisation).





## **Twelve Large Soil Anomalies Identified**



Final results received from the CSIRO UFF Soil Study.

- **Twelve significant soil anomalies** identified to be drill tested.
  - 6 x large Gold anomalies
  - 4 x large Platinum, Nickel & Palladium anomalies
  - 2 x large rock chip/UFF+ lithium anomalies.












Anomaly has significant gold rock chips, highest grades, **126g/t & 67g/t** 





### Breakaway Well – 5km Gold Soil Anomaly






- 5km by 2km long coincident gold and multielement soil anomaly.


Located on the prospective Danjo Granite contact.




 View from the hill adjacent to the Hage's Bore UFF+ anomaly, showing the locations of the nearby gold mines in the Laverton District



### Christmas Gift – 2.5km Pt Cr Ni Soil Anomaly




- 2.5km by 0.5km long multielement soil anomaly.
- Coincident Pt-Cr-Ni anomalism.
- Within a broad NW-SE trending zone of moderate magnetic intensity.
- Hosts the spectacular high-grade gold vein





#### Granite Bore West – 4km Pt Ni Cr Soil Anomaly




- 4km by 0.5km long multielement soil anomaly.
- Coincident Pt Ni & Cr anomalism
- Occurs over mafic rock close to the contact with a granite.





### Granite Bore South – 1.6km Pt Pd Ni Cr Soil Anomaly




- 1.6km by 0.2km long Pt Pd Ni Cr multielement soil anomaly.
- Elevated soil Platinum primarily over mafic rock.
- Palladium is coincident with Platinum, Gold is weakly elevated.





### Bell Bird-4.5km Pt Cr Ni Soil Anomaly




- 4.5km by 0.5km long coincident multielement soil anomaly.
- Areas of coincident Platinum, Chrome & Nickel form a broad arc similar to the distribution of the mafic intrusives.
- The Priority areas are adjacent to a curvilinear magnetic feature.





#### Monument – New 245km<sup>2</sup> Granted Tenements




- Identified a suite of prospective intrusions off the south west corner of the project while field validating the Breakaway anomaly.
- Applied for ~272km<sup>2</sup> of new exploration leases.
- Recently granted ~245km<sup>2</sup> of this ground.
- Conducted reconnaissance fieldwork across the Monument Granite dome and identified a number of areas which have the potential for gold as well as lithium.





### 2 New Lithium Rock and Soil Anomalies




- Two new lithium anomalies have been identified within the Monument target area.
- Both were defined by anomalous Lithium and multi-element UFF+ and rock chip assays.
- **14Li001** The anomaly is 10km long and 2km wide, located along the eastern contact of the Monument Granite where it interacts with the Danjo Granite.
- 14Li002 The anomaly is 3km across and located within the Monument Granite overlying an area of focus for structural intersections.


